

Work Package (WP3) – THYME's methodology appliance in Arab area

With the primary goal of transferring the structure of Italian and Spanish methodologies to organizations in partner countries and their tutors, Work Package 3 (WP3) arms them with essential tools to expertly organize and conduct training programs.

This initiative involves working with youth in their home countries of Lebanon and Jordan, where they will attend workshops applying these European methodologies.



Additionally, youth workers from Jordan and Lebanon (different from those who participated in WP2) will actively shadow the process, gaining skills to address challenges in their home countries.

WP3 focuses on transferring the "Head, Heart, and Hands" methodology to Lebanese and Jordanian youth workers and the "Feet, Heart, Head, and Hands" methodology to these same youth workers.

This exchange equips youth workers from partner countries with essential tools for effective training, engaging them in workshops that cover global citizenship, political participation, and intercultural competences.



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Beyond methodology transfer, WP3 motivates and

guides youth associations in partner countries, ensuring high-quality program delivery.

Moreover, youth educators from Lebanon and Jordan will receive specialized training on the Scholas pedagogical approach, which focuses on managing spaces with youngsters to boost their active citizenship and commitment to addressing local and global problems.

Youth educators from these countries will also be trained on the EITD methodology, which addresses the topic of "Global Citizenship."

The impact extends to 145 local youngsters, raising awareness about global citizenship and fostering a perspective of global responsibility.
